

UTTARAN WASH Programme

Overall rationale for continuing operations of Water, Sanitation & Hygiene (WASH) in Bhasan Char:

At Bhasan Char, UTTARAN WASH has been working to ensure that Rohingya refugees, regardless of age, sex, gender, or ability, have access to improved comprehensive WASH facilities by the support of (Welthungerhilfe) WHH to (male:1342, female:1504, total:2846) population including 19 Persons with Disabilities from 628 HH at 5 clusters. UTTARAN WASH team is contributing to the success of the administration regarding WASH sector by maintenance of the water system and SWM. UTTARAN WASH program are working in all of the domains of WASH like as:

- **Supply of potable water increased or maintained:**
 - Repair of Hand-pumps, Deep Tube Well, Water network and Kitchen Tube Well.
 - Ground water network operation and maintenance (Consumable materials, labour, rain water harvesting, flow meter, dosing pump, fuel etc.
- **Repair and maintenance of functional sanitation facilities and infrastructure:**
 - Repair and maintenance of existing latrines and bathing cubicles.
 - Waste bin platform installation and repair
 - Communal and household waste bin distribution
 - Drain cleaning and mosquito prevention
- **Hygiene promotional activities:**
 - Hygiene promotion session
 - Home visit and follow up
 - Formation and meeting with WASH Committee
 - Formation and meeting with Latrine user group
 - Day observation
 - Cleaning campaign
- **Solid waste management:**
 - Waste collection from household level
 - Segregation of waste
 - Transport to the Solid waste management plant

UTTARAN also regularly conducts other survey initiatives, such as those focusing on the significance of having segregated toilets for men and women. Assessing the demand for community bins by measuring the volume of waste that is being produced at the household level. Organize a camp campaign to get people involved in the idea of a clean camp.

- Create ownership through motivation among the staff and volunteers to reduce turnover.

Currently, Uttaran provides comprehensive WASH services in five clusters. Under the JRP-2025 framework, nine WASH actors are providing services in their designated clusters under the JRP-2025 framework.

Uttaran has been assigned a total of eight clusters (five currently occupied and three unoccupied). If Uttaran discontinues its WASH project before December 2025, the FDMN population in these five clusters won't have access to basic WASH services.

It would be quite difficult to relocate Uttaran's clusters to another WASH actor because all of them aligned their programs with JRP-2025. To ensure the well-being and dignity of the allocated population, it is essential for Uttaran to continue its current WASH project until December 2025.
